

YOUNG GUNS CLASS RULES

Young Guns is a 21 and under class. Anyone under the age of 21 can compete.

Membership is not a requirement – but only members can compete in the points. The cost for a Young Guns membership is \$30 for the season. Members are automatically enrolled in the points. Competitors who are already WCD members do not have to pay for a separate Young Guns membership.

All NHRA rules apply at all times. All WCD track rules apply at all times.

There are approximately 10 races scheduled. The final race will also be a points tie-breaker if necessary. Your worst race will be “thrown out” – your best 9 races will be counted.

Points rules:

First round win	30 points
First round lose	15 points
Round win	10 points

No use of electronics is allowed in the competition.

This is a Trophy Class. Race winners and runners-up will receive a plaque at the end of the evening. There are no purse monies.

Season points winner will receive a track jacket, plaque, and gold card for next season. Runner-up will receive a plaque. There is no cash prize.

All events are held in conjunction with the Saturday Junior's Schedule. (See schedule).

Drivers will be offered a minimum of two and a maximum of three time trials as time allows prior to the start of competition.

There will not be any buy backs. However, competitors who lose may move over and continue to run with the Street Legal vehicles even if your vehicle is not street legal.

Anyone under the age of 18 must have a notarized parental permission waiver on file prior to competing.
